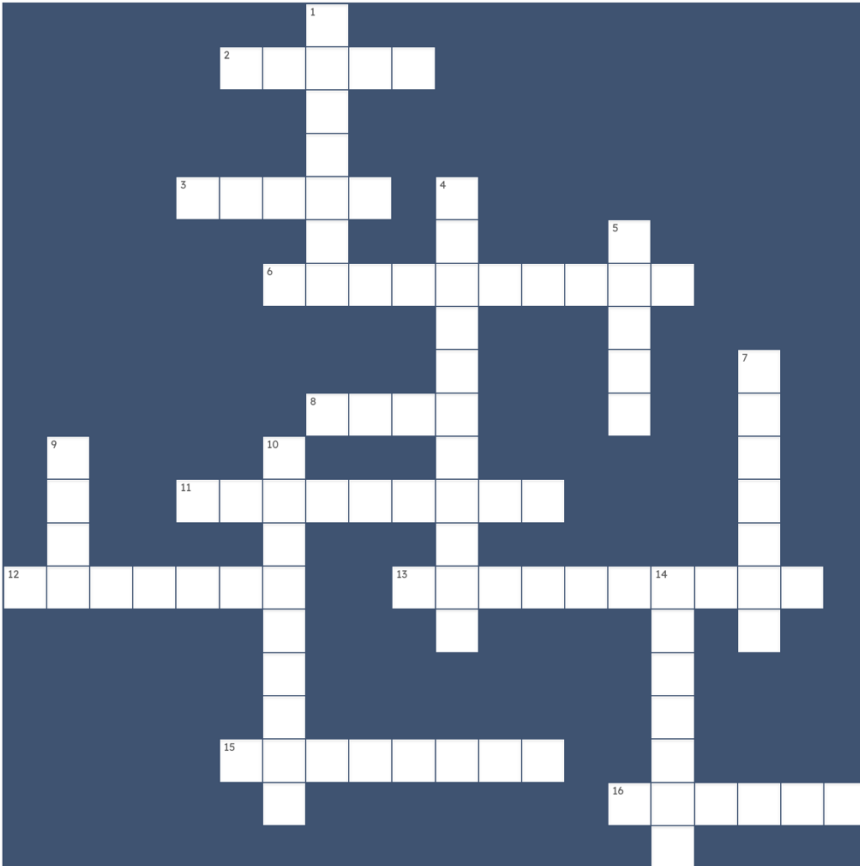




# Clark Public Utilities Crossword
