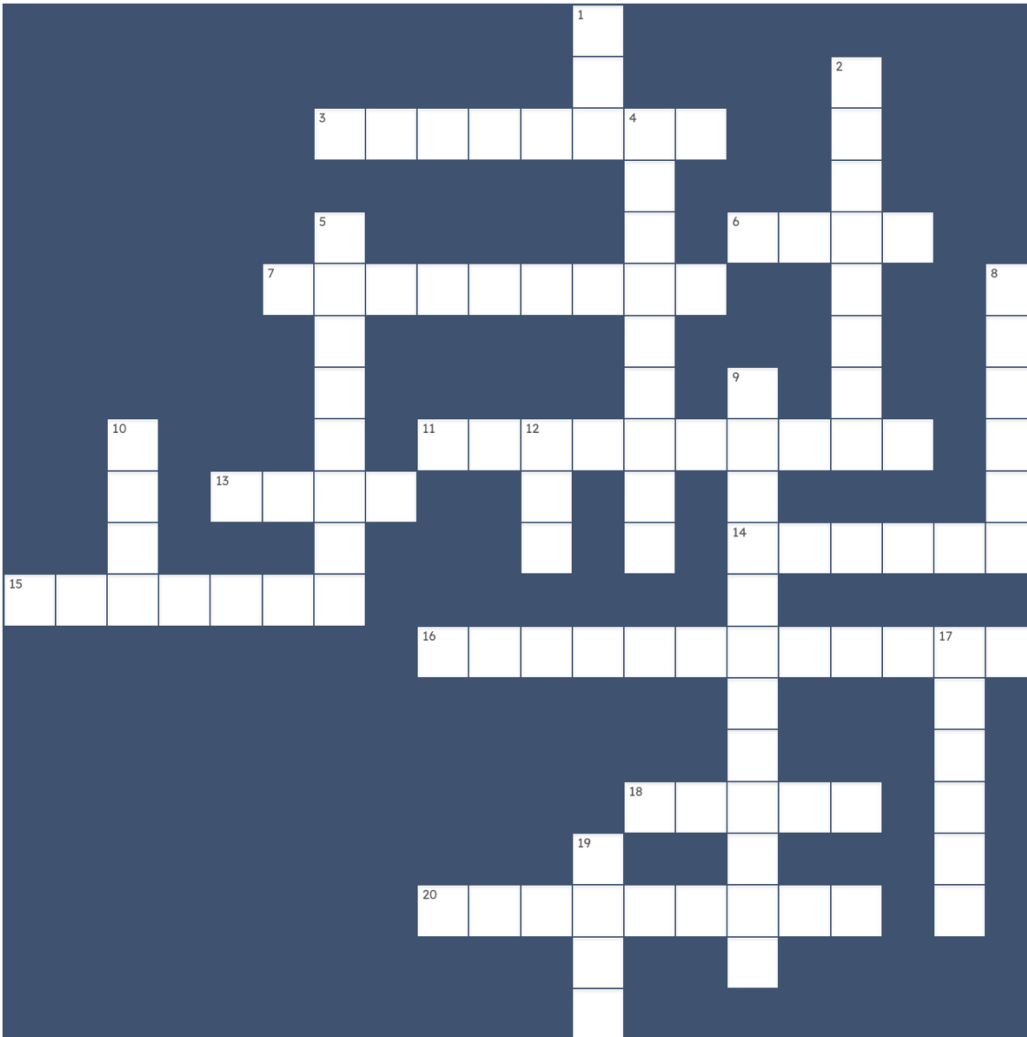




Water Crossword
