



Earth Day Slime Activity

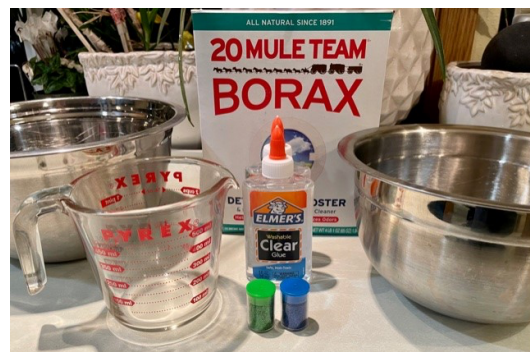


Ready to get started with this activity? To keep track of your progress, check off the instructions for each step below as they are completed.

Consider this: In this activity, you'll be creating a collection of different types of clouds. The pattern for the cloud shapes can be printed out below and then transferred or you can draw your own based on the pattern.

1. Gather Your Materials

- (2) cups of hot water
- (1) teaspoon borax
- ½ cup room temperature water
- (2) bottles of clear glue (5 oz each) – Elmer's works best
- Blue glitter
- Green glitter
- (2) plastic containers for mixing
- (1) container to store the slime



2. Mix Materials in the First Container

- Pour 1 cup hot water into a container.
- Add ½ teaspoon borax.
- Mix well.





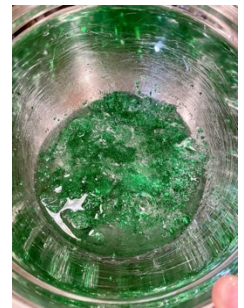
3. Mix Materials in the Second Container

- In a second container, pour ¼ cup room temperature water.
- Squeeze a 5 oz. bottle of clear glue into the room temperature water.
- Add in the blue glitter.



4. Mix Materials Together

- Pour the glue mixture into the hot water and borax mix.
- Let all sit for 20 – 30 seconds.
- Use this time to rinse out the now-empty bowl.



5. Knead the Slime to Help it Set

- The slime will start to form quickly in the hot water. Pull it out and place it in the clean empty bowl.
- The slime will be very sticky at this point, which is okay.
- Knead the slime for a few minutes to help it thicken and set.



6. Get Creative

- Repeat the process all over again but instead use green glitter.
- Once the green is made have fun swirling the colors together.
- Store in an airtight container.
