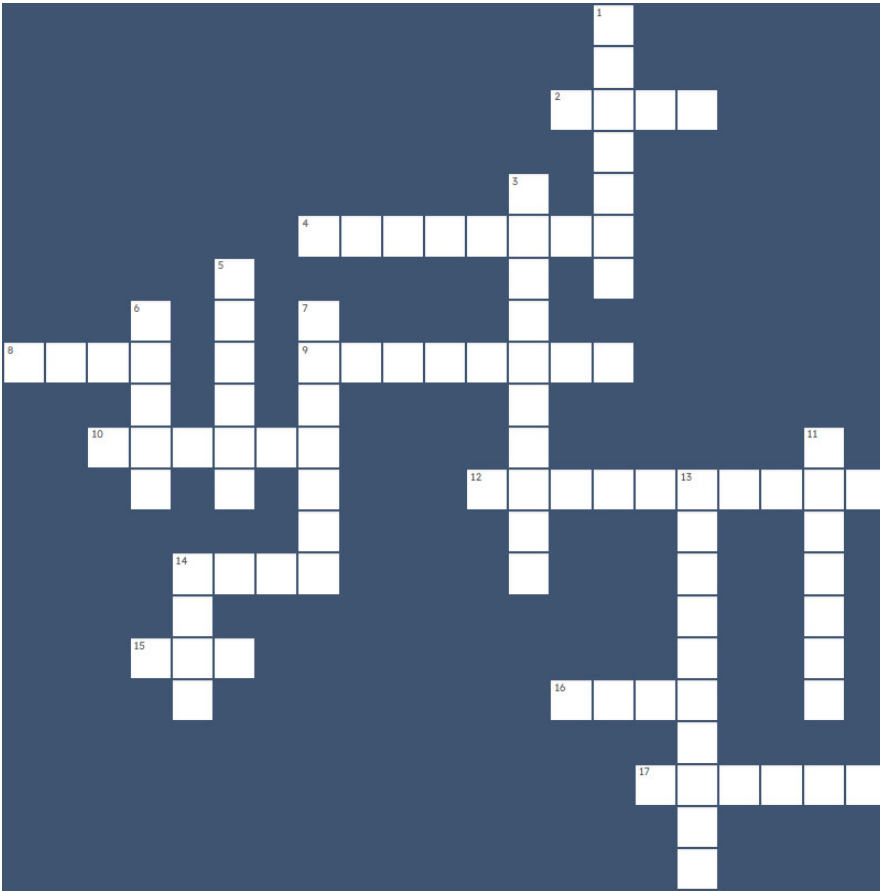




## Salmon Crossword

- 2: A nest of fish eggs in gravel. (4)
- 4: For salmon this occurs in rivers and tributaries. (8)
- 8: A salmon also known as dog, because of the large canine teeth they develop during spawning. (4)
- 9: A place where fish are spawned through human interaction, and raised through the early stages of their life to be released into the wild. (8)
- 10: A newly hatched salmon when still attached to the yolk sac. (6)
- 12: To lessen the impact of a project or development. (10)
- 14: A salmon also known as a humpy or humpback. This is the most abundant Pacific salmon with a short life cycle. (4)
- 15: A recently hatched salmon that can swim and catch its own food. (3)
- 16: A salmon also known as silver. (4)
- 17: The ability of a salmon to correctly identify their home stream. (6)

- 1: A fish egg containing an embryo that has developed enough to see the eyes through the egg membrane. (7)
- 3: A juvenile salmon, up to nine months of age, also known as parr. (10)
- 5: A species that occurs naturally in an area. (6)
- 6: A salmon developmental life stage between parr and adult, at least one year old. (5)
- 7: A salmon known as king, spring, or blackmouth. (8)
- 11: A salmon also known as a red or blueback. Spawning adults develop a dull, green colored head with brick red to scarlet bodies. (7)
- 13: Fish that spend their adult life in the ocean, but swim upriver to freshwater spawning grounds. (10)
- 14: A developmental stage of salmon between alevin and smolt. (4)
